# **CAPTURING MOMENTS:**

The Remarkable Life of Bill Williams

In Nichols Hills, where Bill Williams, the renowned photographer and artist, now resides, his legacy continues to shine through the lens of his camera and the strokes of his paintbrush. Married to his wife of 67 years, Juanita Williams, and blessed with two accomplished daughters, Tamey Fernandez and Tracy Parks, Bill's story is one of creativity, passion, and a lifetime dedicated to the arts.

Bill's journey in the world of visual arts began after graduating from Fairland High School in 1956. His artistic pursuits led him to NEO (Northeastern Oklahoma A&M, Jr. College), where he honed his skills before transferring to Tulsa University, earning a degree in art design. This educational foundation paved the way for a remarkable career that unfolded over the years.

After a stint with Sun Oil/DX in Tulsa, Bill's path took a turn in 1970 when he moved to Norman and assumed the role of art director at the University of Oklahoma. Serving in this capacity until his retirement in 1995, Bill's impact was not only felt in the academic realm but also within the larger community.

Post-retirement, Bill embarked on a global adventure, capturing the essence of landscapes and cultures through his lens. His talent caught the attention of the President of Mexico, leading to commissioned projects for several coffee table books focusing on the State of Chihuahua, Mexico. A

testament to his international recognition, one of Bill's photographs even found a place in the prestigious Louvre Museum in Paris, France.

Meanwhile, Juanita, Bill's wife, contributed her talents to the workforce, working for Pepsi Cola in Tulsa before relocating to Norman in 1970 upon her marriage to Bill. Joining Westinghouse, she dedicated her career to human resources until her retirement in 2000. In 2021, Juanita ventured into the world of entrepreneurship, launching a successful catering business and creating handcrafted accessories in a studio adjacent to Bill's.

Bill's list of accolades includes his promotion at Sunray DX, where he rose from a graphic designer to art director, and at the University of Oklahoma, where he served as president for two years of the Art Directors Association (UCDA). These achievements highlight Bill's commitment to his craft and his influential role in the artistic community.

Beyond the professional sphere, Bill was not just a photographer; he was a juggler, too, showcasing his skills at the annual Medieval Fair in Norman. His love for juggling was instilled by his grandfather, DP Adams, a significant influence in Bill's life.

Today, Bill resides at Iris Senior Living in Nichols Hills, where the walls echo with the stories of a life well-lived. Bill's daughters, Tamey and Tracy, continue the family legacy, each pursuing their unique paths. Tamey and her husband, Paul Fernandez, are enjoying retirement in Norman, while Tracy resides in Tulsa with her husband, Jeff Parks, and works for OU Tulsa in admissions and recruitment.

As readers delve into the fascinating narrative of Bill Williams, they are sure to be inspired by the dedication to art, family, and a life rich with experiences. In this corner of the world, the retired Art Director of the University of Oklahoma leaves behind a legacy of creativity, adventure, and a passion for capturing the beauty that surrounds us all.





# Cultivating Self-Care:

Lauree Dash Shares Mindful Self-Compassion through Restore Behavioral Health

"A moment of self-compassion can change your entire day. A string of such moments can change the course of your life." Christopher K. Germer, PhD.

A year ago, we spoke with Nichols Hills resident Lauree Dash, a certified meditation and mindfulness teacher, and learned about her path of finding inner peace and wisdom through mindfulness and meditation. After completing her mindfulness training in a two-year certification course with Master teachers Jack Kornfield and Tara Brach, Lauree felt called to study and teach Mindful Self Compassion [MSC], the work of Kristin Neff, PhD. and Christopher K. Germer, PhD. She is currently the only trained teacher in Oklahoma for this powerful, resilience-building work and is now offering it through Restore Behavioral Health right here in Oklahoma City, Norman and Edmond. With Mindful Self-Compassion, Lauree has found a way to help herself and others navigate the inevitable suffering of life.

From Soul Yoga to the Wellness Center at INTEGRIS Cancer Institute, Lauree has been on a mission to help people cultivate practices that nourish and support their well-being. Her newest course, "Mindful Self-Compassion", is an 8-week adventure she's excited to share with the patients of Restore Behavioral Health and our Oklahoma community as well.

Lauree's holistic approach isn't just about meditation; it's about developing resources to better care for ourselves. "We all have fierce inner critics," she notes, emphasizing there is a need to break free from destructive self-judgments and learn to be kinder to ourselves. In her course, a simple yet profound exercise called "How to Treat a Friend" challenges participants to reflect on how they treat themselves compared to how they would treat a friend facing the same difficulties.

Kelly Lashar, LPC and Operations Manager/Cofounder at Restore Behavioral Health, sees Lauree's class as a perfect fit for their holistic approach to mental health. "We want to offer a service that includes mindfulness, meditation, and yoga," says Kelly, who, along with her business partner Gina Dixon, founded Restore

seven years ago. They've grown from a team of two to a staff of 60 counselors, serving nearly 1000 clients each week.

Lauree's journey to Restore was facilitated by Molly Ross Fuhrman, a colleague from her work at Integris and counselor at Restore. Having taken Lauree's Mindful Self-Compassion course, Molly recognized its potential and believed it fit seamlessly with Restore's vision. "We want the public to get to know Lauree and the peace and calm that she emanates," Kelly expresses, highlighting the transformative impact they hope Lauree's class will have on their community.

As winter descends and the days grow shorter, mental health concerns can take center stage. Lauree's class can help clients with the "winter blues", mental exhaustion that stems from the stress of the season and the hectic lifestyle it brings. "Mindfulness is learning how to be with uncomfortable or difficult thoughts and feelings. It's about being intentional; and Mindful Self-Compassion is about recognizing those moments when we are suffering, knowing we are not alone and learning to give ourselves kindness," Lauree explains. She says, "This illuminates the three core components of mindful self-compassion identified by Dr. Neff: mindfulness, common humanity, and self-directed kindness.

"We receive so many messages on so many screens constantly. We are overstimulated," Lauree observes, pointing out how our bodies absorb stress, pushing us into a perpetual fight, flight or freeze state. This stress can lead to health issues as well as negative effects on our relationships and ourselves. Mindfulness, meditation, and therapy become the tools to hit the reset button. "You can be a changing force when you walk into a room. You can change





the energy in that room," she adds, emphasizing the transformative power of intentional presence.


